WASTEWATER

WATER FROM INSIDE OUR BUILDINGS. GOES DOWN THE PIPES INTO SEWAGE PIPES.

IT FLOWS INTO SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANTS BEFORE BEING DISPERSED INTO THE ENVIRONMENT.

STORMWATER

WASTEWATER FROM OUTSIDE OUR BUILDINGS. GOES DOWN ROADSIDE DRAINS OR STORMWATER GRATES ON ROADS, YARDS AND CAR PARKS.

IT FLOWS INTO STORMWATER PIPES WHICH CARRY RUN-OFF TO THE NEAREST STREAM, HARBOUR AND BEACH.

BIRDS, MAMMALS, FISH

CAN SUFFER INFECTION AND LOSS OF LIMBS FROM PLASTIC FRAGMENTS. THE PLASTIC THAT MARINE ANIMALS SWALLOW, STAYS IN THEIR STOMACH AND ATTRACTS OTHER POISONS.

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
